Cell Phone-Expert Professional Profile

Breck McDaniel is an honorably retired sergeant from the Houston Police Department who retired in October 2015 after twenty years of service with over seventeen years of investigative assignments. He now works full-time, offering law enforcement training and expert witnessing and consulting services regarding cell phone information used in support of law enforcement investigations and prosecutions, as well as civil cases not impinging upon law enforcement efforts. In 2005, while still working full-time as an investigator, he formed his training company, Geocell, LLC (www.geocell.us). He offers expert witnessing and consulting services under a second company he formed in 2013, Cellular Evidence Services, LLC (www.cellularevidence.com). He also formed a private investigations company, BCM Investigations, LLC (Texas-company-license A04075401), and provides digital device forensics as a licensed private investigator (Texas personal private investigator-(PI)-registration-number 00299789). His primary expert-hired cases involve questions of potential driver distraction by cell phones. Breck is also a volunteer sworn peace officer investigator with the Kendall County District Attorney's Office in Boerne, Texas (just outside of San Antonio), and is a Texas-licensed attorney.

In addition to several years of assignments as a patrol officer/sergeant, where he investigated hundreds of motor vehicle accidents, the vast majority of his full-time law enforcement career was spent in investigative assignments. His investigative positions have included working undercover in the Narcotics Division, as an investigator in the Family Violence Unit, over five years as a Homicide investigator, and as the founder and former supervisor of the electronic Communications Intelligence Unit (CIU). He also formerly supervised the computer and cell phone forensics unit known as the Digital Forensics Lab (DFL) and spent the last five years of his career supervising general investigators. As a result of extensive training and real-world experience, he developed a very rare specialty in the field of electronic "communications intelligence," especially related to cellular telephone information.

Breck has also worked extensively with global positioning system (GPS)/global navigation satellite systems (GNSS) systems such as vehicle telemetry systems (e.g., "tracking devices" and tracking logs on commercial vehicles and passenger-vehicle location information such as those from the General Motors' OnStar system) as well as vehicle and asset tracking units used in law enforcement surveillances (e.g., "mobile tracking devices"). As it relates to motor vehicle collisions, while he did not act as a full-time accident investigator, Breck did handle hundreds of motor vehicle accidents as a patrol officer and sergeant with the Houston Police Department. Further, he has extensive experience working with 911 records, 911-call recordings, 911-call routings, 911/dispatch records, and the like.

While serving as a homicide investigator for over five years, he investigated hundreds of major violent crimes, such as homicides and kidnappings. While doing so, he personally investigated homicides, including well over 100 cases as a primary investigator. In fact, he achieved significant successes in these investigations, clearing the vast majority of cases and developing extremely thorough and well-rounded major case investigation skills. Noteworthy accomplishments included significant successes with obtaining admissible confessions and extensive experience testifying in well over 100 formal criminal court proceedings.

Substantial experience has also been obtained testifying at length in support of complex investigations. Extensive testimonial experience includes civil depositions, legislative testimony, and courtroom testimony in state, county, parole, juvenile, and federal criminal courts/hearings. He has been

retained in hundreds of expert matters in various state and federal courts and in Canada. He has prepared formal reports and testified formally regarding information on electronic communications in well over a hundred civil and criminal matters.

In addition, numerous major cases investigated and/or solved by Breck have been featured numerous times on national and international media outlets such as CBS's "48 Hours," NBC's "Dateline," ABC's "Primetime" and 20/20, Lifetime Network, Court TV, TruTV's "Forensics Files," an Australian version of the Discovery Channel, and Oxygen Network's Cold Justice.

During his time as a homicide investigator, he developed expertise in working with electronic communications information, especially cell phone information, to successfully solve and enhance cases. Especially noteworthy successes were achieved by promptly rescuing scores of kidnapping victims, quickly locating hundreds of major violent fugitives, and significantly enhancing hundreds of major investigations and prosecutions. Breck has also achieved significant success with the visual presentations of cell phone information in front of juries in many cases.

Breck is a basic and advanced certified law enforcement instructor in Texas and has formally presented to others in law enforcement regarding the use of electronic communications information extensively, having presented collectively to over 14,000 attendees in on-duty, volunteer, and compensated capacities in local, state, regional, national, and Internet settings in over 285 formal presentations for over 2,750 clock-hours of presentations. As a result, he has developed and presented dozens of presentations ranging from thirty minutes to five days. He has also authored cell phone materials that have been published by the International Association of Chiefs of Police (IACP).

In addition to providing training and expertise, Breck has also attended an extensive amount of training on electronic communications, especially cell phones, including attendance at over 150 separate formal events that total over 1,780 hours of formal attendance related to this specialized subject since 2004. Breck also continues to be extremely active in monitoring the electronic communications intelligence field, with continuing efforts that include seeking out available training opportunities and being very active via professional networking with others in the field. Breck is also a member of the National Technical Investigators' Association (NATIA), the American Academy of Forensic Sciences (AAFS), and the Texas District and County Attorneys' Association (TDCAA).

Breck is also a former voting member of the United States' Scientific Working Group on Digital Evidence (SWGDE), which is sponsored/administered by federal law enforcement such as the FBI, DHS, and/or Secret Service. As a member of SWGDE, he was the impetus behind, and one of the principal authors of, SWGDE Recommendations for Cell Site Analysis, originally published on September 26, 2017. ***But most importantly, Breck has successfully utilized cell phone information in hundreds of major investigations, in hundreds of hired cases, and continues to work with the information regularly.***

Breck possesses a Bachelor of Arts (BA) in Government and a Master of Science (MS) in Technology Commercialization, both from the University of Texas at Austin. He also possesses an MS in Criminal Justice from Sam Houston State University, including a graduate certificate in Criminal Justice Leadership and Management. Additionally, he possesses a Juris Doctor (JD) from Mitchell Hamline School of Law and a Master of Laws (LL.M.) in Trial Advocacy from Temple University's Beasley School of Law. Breck is also a licensed attorney in the States of Texas (Bar #24136232), New Mexico (Bar #165217), and New York (Bar # 6311542).

Breck grew up in the Dallas area and currently lives in the San Antonio area with his wife, a twenty-seven-year Texas prosecutor and the current 498th District Court Judge in Kendall County, Texas, and their eighteen-year-old son, a freshman engineering student at Purdue University.

Communications-Related Legislative Accomplishments

Breck McDaniel has spearheaded several legislative bills in the State of Texas, including drafting major portions of the legislation, assisting with securing legislative sponsors in the Texas Senate and House, testifying in hearings, and working with stakeholders on the relevant issues until the bills were finally passed. Communications-related legislation significantly supported by Breck McDaniel includes the following:

- **Senate Bill 823, 80th Legislature, effective May 23rd, 2007**, modified Texas law to allow for major local agencies to conduct non-emergency pen registers (electronic surveillance) in addition to other related changes.
- **Senate Bill 244, 80th Legislature, effective September 1st, 2007**, modified Texas law to allow for the sealing of search warrants in certain criminal investigations.
- **Senate Bill 2047, 81st Legislature, effective September 1st, 2009**, modified Texas law to update it to be consistent with federal law and allow Texas investigators access to all stored electronic communications, such as voicemails. The bill also made other related changes.
- **House Bill 2086, 81st Legislature, effective September 1st, 2009**, modified Texas law to allow for roaming communications intercepts (wiretaps) with surveillance targets who frequently change communications devices. Initially, it was Senate Bill 385, and the relevant text was added to House Bill 2086, which passed.
- **Senate Bill 537, 81st Legislature, effective September 1st, 2009**, modified Texas law to allow for additional judges to issue communications intercept (wiretap) orders.
- **Senate Bill 687 and House Bill 1457, 82nd Legislature, 2011**, was a legislative initiative to allow major local police and sheriff agencies in Texas to conduct communications intercepts (wiretaps) in non-emergency investigations. This initiative passed the Senate in 2011. However, it ran out of time before passing the House of Representatives. This initiative was pursued by the 2013 legislature but failed once more.
- **House Bill 2268, 83rd Legislature, effective June 14th, 2013**, provided several years of significant initial assistance that led to this 2013 modification of Texas search warrant law, which now allows for a “long-arm” search warrant provision to clearly allow for the use of stored electronic communications search warrants for information stored with communications providers outside of the State of Texas and for the honoring of out of state search warrants.
