Christopher's career service includes response and investigation to well over 500 CMV crashes to include hazardous material loads, bulk cargo tanks, and passenger carrying vehicles such as buses.

Trained as a Level 1 FMCSA inspector, Christopher brings experience and knowledge gathered through more than 5,000 roadside and post-crash inspections. This real-world knowledge is backed with an extensive understanding of Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations developed through conducting safety audits order by FMCSA. The results yield detailed yet practical reports that will assist in navigating transport related matters that arise from investigating CMV crashes.

In addition to enforcement and safety audit experience, Christopher's training and experience stems from operating commercial truck and trailer combination while employed by an excavation company after retiring from law enforcement. Experience includes interstate transportation construction machinery and moving construction material in dump trucks. Operation of large trucks further dates to 2001 where he was trained as Motor Transport Operator (tactical vehicles) after enlisting in the United States Marine Corps. During his 4 years enlistment, Christopher developed experience driving in a wide range of climates, terrains, and stressful conditions to prepare for combat operations. He participated in hauling dangerous cargo such as jet fuel and ammunitions to include tank and artillery rounds. This venture also sent him overseas to Japan. As a ranking supervisor, he coordinated and participated in the transport of thousands of troops within live military operations. It was also the military that gave him his first look and training and licensing other troops to operate smaller trucks that the Marine Corps used.

The military experience proved valuable during Christopher's law enforcement career with the Massachusetts State Police. After 10 years developing his skills as a patrol officer, he interviewed and was accepted to join the Commercial Vehicle Enforcement Section. It was here that he excelled and took on a wide range of responsibilities to include; FMCSA certified inspector, sworn weigher

and measurer (overweight / oversized trucks), safety auditor, and commercial driver licensing. CDL licensing was the biggest eye opener as he learned first hand the amount of knowledge and training that not only has to be learned, but also demonstrated to obtain a CDL license. This firsthand knowledge together with extensive understanding of FMCSA and state CDL manuals can paint a valuable picture that will assist in understanding how CMV crashes can be or should be avoided.
