Profile: Highly qualified and well-rounded expert opinions are supported by nearly 30-years’ experience in public safety with over 24 years of involvement in the highly specialized field of commercial motor vehicle (CMV, meaning “truck”) crashes, incidents, inspections, and enforcement. Scot’s CMV experience includes 7 years as the program manager of the Commercial Carrier Section for the Wyoming Highway Patrol (WHP). Specializing in scene investigation including CMV crash investigations, supervising large CMV incidents on state highways and Interstates, and reviewing post-crash/incident CMV inspection/investigations, Scot’s career of service includes over 11 years of investigating CMV tractor-trailer crashes, 13 years of reviewing CMV crash reports, incident reports and inspections. After retiring from WHP Scot joined the Kansas Highway Patrol where he worked for nearly two years as a Data Q Specialist and CMV Inspector. Scot was responsible for processing all DataQs filed in Kansas which included review of the files, investigation of the circumstances, review of relevant FMCSRs, and providing a detailed response to the request for review.

Trained in Level 1 FMCSA CMV roadside enforcement inspections including Hazardous Materials, Scot’s in-depth knowledge of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations, detailed and well written reports, in-depth knowledge of applicable standards of care and professionally delivered testimony can be a focal point of any civil or criminal litigation or arbitration where CMV crashes, with or without hazardous material involvement and/or transport related matters are at issue.

In addition to his years of experience responding to and/or investigating truck crashes, Scot spent seven years as the Commercial Carrier Program manager for WHP within this role was the management of the CMV inspection program, management of Waste Isolation Pilot Plant (WIPP) shipments through Wyoming, rules promulgation, and legislative liaison for statutory updates regarding highway safety, including commercial vehicle statutes.

During part of the years as detailed above, from 2005-2018 Scot was an instructor for the Wyoming Highway Patrol. In this specific discipline, Scot taught traffic laws to law enforcement officers in both city/county agencies as well as the WHP.

Scot has inspected many Commercial Motor Vehicles for road worthiness as required by the FMCSA both during his career with WHP and his time at KHP. While with KHP, Scot reviewed hundreds of roadside inspections for accuracy and provided written responses to the requestor regarding the outcome of his review. These reviews required in depth investigation into all aspects of the inspection from the accuracy of company/driver information to the applicability of the FMCSRs listed as violations. These responses provided the requestor with detailed information regarding the FMCSR violations listed on the inspection.

While Scot's is fairly new in the CMV expert consulting field the work taps into his many years of work in the CMV safety arena which honed his investigative skills and expanded his attention to detail when reviewing incidents. It provides him a rich experience whereas he reviews crash scene/site investigations and inspections, litigation support and examining discovery documents and evidence, whereas he is confident in compiling a seemingly impossible universe of documents together, into a well-constructed report in the most difficult and complex of cases.
